Altitude 500 Car Regulations

Altitude 500 provides you with vehicles free of charge to take you to your place of work. These vehicles are in perfect working order and are regularly serviced.

We ask each team of workers to designate a car manager. This person will be in charge of the vehicle, will be responsible for driving it and will be liable in the event of any problems.

If a fine (traffic or other) is issued, it will be deducted from the team's pay!

If damage is caused to the car (accident, damaged car, car too dirty, etc.), this will also be deducted from the team's pay!

We ask you to take care of the vehicles, respect the speed limits and try not to get them too dirty.

When you go to the Christmas tree plot (in the fields), please do not drive onto it, but stay on the path so as not to get stuck and damage the car. The car must remain at the edge of the field.

When you return the car before leaving, an Altitude 500 manager will come to check that everything is in order. Photos of the car were taken before we gave it to you on arrival. We ask that you clean the car thoroughly (inside and outside) before returning it. You can use the company's cleaning equipment by asking at the office.

Any damage or costs (legal proceedings, etc.) will be deducted from your pay, so please take care of the equipment.
