ISO 28000: A few rules on safety

This document is intended for all new arrivals (employees, workers, seasonal workers or freelancers) and will be given to each person from September 2024.

As Altitude 500 is ISO 28000 certified, this document will give you a brief overview of what this means for everyone.

What is the ISO 28000 standard?

« ISO 28000 - 2022 provides a framework of good practice for reducing safety risks in all activities, functions and operations that have an impact on the organisation's safety management, including (but not limited to) its supply chain. It can be used in all aspects of the organisation's security ».*

What we expect from you:

- *To be attentive and pro-active regarding anything that may appear abnormal or suspicious to you on the A500 site and in the plots. To report any suspicious behaviour without delay, whether it comes from a colleague, a customer, a carrier or any other person.
- *Respect the instructions and recommendations of line managers and team leaders.
- *Respect the rules in place on the Altitude 500 site.
- *Comply with safety instructions (wearing appropriate equipment, keeping safe distances, etc.).
- *To report any damage (platform, buildings, plots of land) that you see and which could represent a danger to the company.
- *Report any access that is not closed or any failure to open and/or close doors, barriers, etc.
- *To use only authorised areas.
- *Do not attempt to harm the business or A500 in general in any way whatsoever during the entire progress of the suply-chain.

It is very important to follow these rules and to work as a 'good father', otherwise, A500 reserves the right to separate from the worker.
