

Internal regulations

A. PREMISES AND EQUIPMENT

You are asked to use the premises and equipment provided in a responsible manner:

- tea towels
- brushes
- raclettes
- cleaning products
- furniture

It is important to put the material (whatever it is) back in its original place to facilitate the inventory.

B. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING AND HYGIENE

On arrival at the gîte, it will be offered in a state of maximum cleanliness and comfort.

- It is imperative that the premises are kept clean throughout the stay by daily basic cleaning.

Cleaning.

- For strict hygiene reasons, the permanent maintenance of kitchen equipment and utensils, work tables, toilets, etc. must also be ensured.

- It is essential to use the appropriate "bin" bags. It is requested to put the filled bags and closed in the appropriate container.

- In order to keep the building clean and in perfect working order, everyone is required to

They are personally responsible for their room. It is requested that beds and wardrobes are not displaced.

- A common responsibility will exist in order to safeguard the collective equipment. Any deterioration of property or equipment will be sanctioned by either individual or collective reimbursement.

C. FORMAL PROHIBITIONS

- to take animals into the gîte.
- moving furniture or beds
- to put the dining room furniture outside
- to enter and exit through the emergency doors.
- smoking inside the gîte.
- to throw cigarette butts on the pavement.
- to bring heating and cooking appliances into the gîte.

- possessing and using drugs
- abusive consumption of alcohol is prohibited
- Heating in the bedrooms: it is FORBIDDEN to put anything on the electric radiators as there is a risk of fire!

D. SECURITY

It is urged not to lock yourself in your room at any time of the day or night. This is a matter of individual and collective safety.

E. EXTERIOR

If there is a green space dedicated to the gîte, it is allowed for the organisation of relaxation activities. The equipment

Any barbecues used for this purpose must be removed before departure and the site returned in its original condition. If an outdoor barbecue is provided. The grills must be cleaned and the ashes removed before departure.

F. DRESS AND HYGIENE

Proper dress is required in the school as well as good personal hygiene.

G. ENVIRONMENT

Strict respect for the environment and neighbours is required.

Care must be taken not to cause a disturbance to the neighbourhood by making undue noise. In general, all noisy activities must be stopped after 10 p.m.

H. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The present rules have no other purpose than to allow you to have the most pleasant stay in the gîte and to perpetuate with the owners of the gîtes a healthy and durable collaboration.

Consumption (heating, water, electricity) will be charged to you, so be careful not to overdo it.

Remember to turn off the heating when you are not in the house!
