

Chain saw



1. Instructions for use

Preparation:

- Read the user manual carefully.
- Wear personal protective equipment (PPE):
- Helmet with visor or safety goggles
- Ear muffs or ear plugs
- Reinforced, cut-resistant gloves
- Cut-resistant pants or leggings
- Safety shoes with protective toe caps and puncture-resistant soles

Checks before use:

- Check:
- Chain (condition, tension, lubrication)
- Chain brake
- Oil level in the chain
- Fuel level (gasoline chainsaws)
- Guide bar in good condition
- All controls working normally

Starting work:

- Place the chainsaw on the ground in an open area.
- Activate the chain brake.
- For gasoline models: Start with your foot on the rear handle and one hand on the front handle.

- For electric/battery models: Make sure the switch is in the OFF position before turning on or inserting the battery.

Use:

- Use both hands at all times.
- Maintain a stable position with your feet firmly planted on the ground.
- Hold the chain saw close to your body for better control.
- Always work below shoulder height.
- Beware of kickback: avoid using the upper part of the tip of the bar.

End of use:

- Switch off the engine or disconnect the power supply.
- Activate the chain brake.
- Clean the chain saw (chain, housing, air filter).
- Loosen the chain slightly if it has been stored for a long time.
- Store in a safe and dry place.

2. Safety instructions

Personal safety:

- Never use a chainsaw:
- At height without special equipment
- When you are tired, under the influence of alcohol or medication
- In windy or unstable weather (for outdoor work)

Workplace safety:

- Never cut with the tip of the bar (risk of kickback).
- Always engage the chain brake when moving between cuts.
- Keep people at least 15 meters away.
- Never use alone: always tell someone or work in pairs.

Maintenance and storage:

- Check regularly:
- Chain tension and sharpness
- Chain oil level and quality
- Never use a worn, loose, or poorly sharpened chain.
- Store in a place inaccessible to children, in a well-ventilated area, away from moisture.
