machine for wrapping Christmas trees in netting



1. Instructions for use

Preparation:

- Ensure that the net bale is correctly mounted on the machine shaft, according to the manufacturer's instructions (direction of unwinding).
- Pass the net through the insertion tube (or cone) to the outlet, so that it is ready to receive the trees.
- Check that the tunnel (gaulotta) is clean and free of obstacles (residue or old net).

Net insertion operation:

- 1. Hold the tree firmly by the base or upper branches so that you can guide it straight into the tunnel entrance.
- 2. Insert the base of the tree into the net tunnel.
- 3. Push the tree continuously and evenly through the tunnel:
 - o Make sure it moves straight and centered.
 - o Visually check how the net wraps around the tree.
- 4. Once the tree is fully inserted into the net, retrieve it from the machine outlet.

Changing the bale and cleaning:

1. Stop the machine and disconnect the power supply before changing the net roll.

- 2. Remove the empty roll and install a new one, ensuring it is wound in the correct direction.
- 3. Clean the tunnel and net contact areas to prevent resin or dirt build-up.

2. Safety instructions

Personal protective equipment (PPE):

- Protective gloves to avoid cuts or scratches caused by the net or branches.
- Safety glasses or a visor to prevent resin, splinters, or dust from getting in your eyes.
- Protective footwear with reinforced toes and non-slip soles to prevent slipping.

Checks before use:

- Check the stability of the machine: place it on a flat, dry, and stable surface.
- Check that the net bale is correctly secured (no slack or misalignment).
- Check the overall condition of the net: no cuts, tangled or blocked sections.
- Check that the emergency stop button is easily accessible and functional.
- Make sure the area around the machine is clean, clear, and well lit.

Instructions during use:

- Ensure that only trained and authorized personnel use the machine.
- Keep hands and arms away from the net drive area and the insertion tube.
- Never insert your hands into the area where the tree passes through the tube (risk of entanglement and crushing).
- Maintain a stable and ergonomic posture when inserting the tree.
- Do not force the tree into the tube: insertion should be smooth and steady.
- Monitor the correct deployment of the net during operation.
- Do not leave the machine running unattended.

Instructions in case of blockage or problem:

- If the tree or net gets stuck:
- Immediately stop the machine using the emergency stop button.
- Do not attempt to manually remove the obstacle while the machine is powered.
- Disconnect the power supply before any intervention (unplug or switch off at the panel).
- Report any anomaly (excessive wear, suspicious noises, unusual vibrations) to a manager.

After use:

- Clean the machine (dust, net debris) with a brush or industrial vacuum cleaner (avoid using your hands).
- Check the general condition of the machine and the cleanliness of the work area.

- Store opened mesh bales in a dry and safe place.
- Disconnect the power supply to prevent accidental start-up.

3. Basic maintenance instructions

• Clean the machine at the end of each working day to prevent the accumulation of net or resin residue.

Weekly checks:

- Condition of rollers or net bales (no tears or broken threads).
- Tightness of fasteners (screws, bale fastening pins).
- Cleanliness of the feed tube.
- Lightly lubricate moving parts if recommended by the manufacturer (see technical manual).
- Have a complete annual inspection carried out by qualified personnel (maintenance service or authorized supplier).
